What makes you happy? Think about what you could do to make your friends happy?</li> <li>Can you draw a picture of what makes you happy and talk about it?</li> <li>Would you like to try some children's yoga? Can you support your child to arrange these numbers in order? Who did the Stick man meet on his journey? What was their favourite part of the story and why?</li> <li>Can you create your own picture/model of the stick man or his family tree?</li> <li>Can you identify rhyming words within the story? e.g. <b>jog/dog, stick/trick, best/nest</b></li> <li>You could also go a walk and see if you can find any sticks and make the stick man family?</li> <li>You can find further stick man activities here: <a href="https://www.stickmanofficial.com/activities/">https://www.stickmanofficial.com/activities/</a></li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Gloop</b> - Can you help to measure and mix the ingredients? Have a guess to see what you think will float and what will sink. You can even record this and show us your results!</li> <li><b>Den building</b> – Collect covers, blankets and pillows and see if you can build a fort to hide in. why not use this as story den?</li> <li><b>Puppets</b> – Can you create your own puppets? Use any old/loose objects you can find around the house and glue/stick them onto a pair of old socks. Can you use your puppet to tell a story or make a puppet show?</li> <li><b>Lego</b> – What can you build from your Lego?
